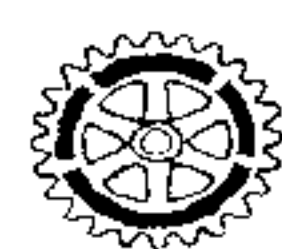

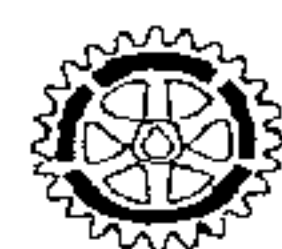
Volunteers are needed for catering at the Polo Fiat airstrip on December 5 from 10.30 to 1pm.
