

A big night for our outgoing President and Board Members


BBQ: At the markets made \$499.70 profit last Sunday

Julie J: reported that Carlo P's daughter Luisa will be going to Germany next year on exchange.




Darrell G: then read an article from Ansett's in flight magazine on fitness. Thanks Darrell, now we all feel bad.


We then: walked the main streets of Cooma recalling the business houses that have come and gone over the years.
