

The guest speaker, Cameron Rogers, gave us a very interesting talk on acupuncture and assured us his needles are painless!!




Market Day: July 18th. Market Day Roster: Rob S, Col A, Bill R, Geoff B, and Des T. If unable to attend please find a replacement.
