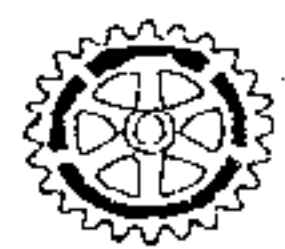
THOUGHT OF THE WEEK by Brian J
