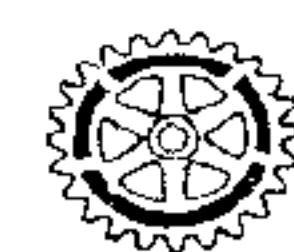

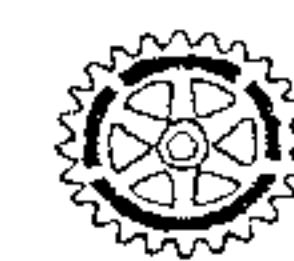
Clean-up Australia Day: was very successful. Five schools involved also.
