ROTARY INFORMATION: Rotary Central/Eastern Europe

In the 11 years since Rotary was re-established there, Central/Eastern Europe has become Rotary's fastest growing region. As of 31 December 1999, there were 348 Rotary Clubs with 9,684 members in 24 former Communist Countries. Membership grew by at least 10% in the 1998-99 Rotary year. The count for the new Rotary countries does not even include the 3,371 Rotarians in Clubs in the new Federal States of Germany, the former German Democratic Republic. RI President Carlo Ravizza called the groundbreaking Budapest workshop a great success. (Rotarian, May p39)
