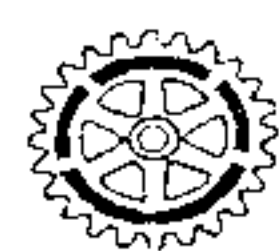

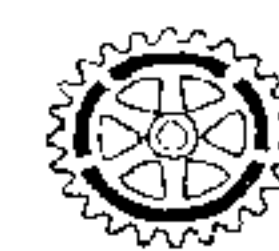

**ROTARY INFORMATION:** *Education First Line of Defence Against HIV in Bangladesh*

"Our Neighbours waited ... must we, too?" The powerful slogan, adopted by Bengali Rotarians in their HIV/AIDS education crusade, is particularly appropriate. More than four million people are living with the disease in neighbouring India. An additional 330,000 cases have been reported in Myanmar, and 800,000 in Thailand.
