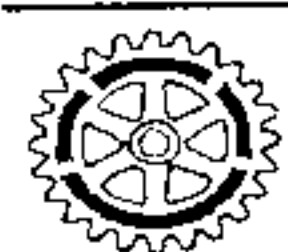

Market Promotional Fund \$159.26.

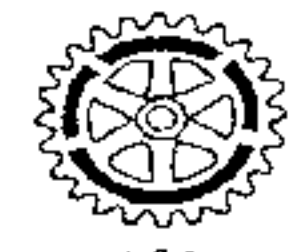

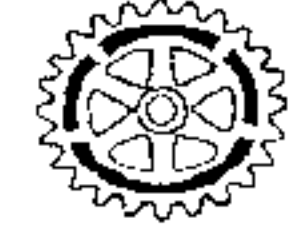

In 1969, I was sponsored by the Rotary Club of Waikerie, South Australia, to serve as a member of the 1970 Group Study Exchange to Utah and Idaho, USA. The experience had a profound effect on me. I traveled with six other young Australians, all of whom were destined to become leaders in their professions. One of my teammates, Dean Brown, later became Premier of South Australia.
