





The polio Eradication Initiative received unprecedented recognition from US physicians in June, when then RI President Carlo Ravizza, on behalf of the International Partnership, accepted the AMA first ever Outstanding Global Health Initiative Award. AMA President-elect, Randolph D Smoak, MD applauded Rotary and its partners. To date, Rotary has contributed US\$373 million to the protection of nearly two billion children.
