ROTARY INFORMATION: Rotarian's New Meeting Site Doubles as Medical Centre

For 50 years, the Rotary Club of Jamnager, India, had wanted its own building, a place not only for regular club meetings, but a site that would also serve as a community medical facility. Because constructing such a facility would require significant funding, the club sought support through a listing in the World Community Service Projects Exchange, and the Rotary Club of Birmingham, England, responded with a pledge of financial assistance. Named Rotary Community Centre. Inaugurated on 11th February 2000. (The Rotarian/January p.53)
