Ninety years ago, a Chicago businessman named Paul P Harris mulled over the best way to spread the word of a relatively new organisation that he founded in 1905, called Rotary. He decided to publish a 12 page black and white tabloid newspaper entitled the National Rotarian. Published in January 1911, the main feature was an essay penned by Paul Harris "Rational Rotarianism".
