Mick Klima was born and reared in Cooma, Taught PE in Wagga Wagga before embarking on a world skiing tour. 20 years ago he returned to Cooma and opened a ski shop. Very involved in youth programs, particularly soccer. and when Gabby Wilks, an Argentinean who is coach of the Cooma Tigers, suggested a junior soccer trip to Argentina. Mick got heavily involved in fund raising events to assist raising \$75,000 for the trip, each player also had to provide \$3,000. 22 were selected, aged between 16-17. They

played 9 games against top clubs there and won 1. The visiting Cooma team had the privilege of playing with, against and be coached by world

class players. Most newer soccer fields in Argentina have tennis courts and a swimming pool. Youth are heavily involved in sport, with fewer computers or TV Programs, and less obesity. The countries biggest export is soccer players and they export about 20,000 each year for big money. 3 of the Cooma team have stayed on in Argentina to play and be coached there. The team also visited Chile. Another trip to South America is being organised this year for 20 youths.
