The guest Speaker was Kirsty Herbert, who has worked in the aged care sector of our community for the last 16 years. Working towards excellence in caring for our elderly citizens has become her passion. She is currently the Coordinator of the Snowy Monaro Respite Cottages for Cooma Challenge, who recently obtained a federal grant to supply overnight and daycare respite services to people who are caring for older people or Dementia sufferers to give carers a break or rest from their caring role. She informed us who these services are available to. Also showed us overviews of the respite Cottage in Vagg Street, its furnishing, and volunteers assisting with upgrade. Staff at this cottage have gold standard in Dementia and a Certificate 111 in aged care. **FUNDING** 5 nights stay, 24 hour care, all meals at cost of \$ 20 per day, No doubt this is a very great asset to our aging community, especially as respite care at nursing homes in the area has a 12 month waiting list.
