Jackie Graham-Cooma Time Walk

Katrin Hackney gave a report of the week-end's Australia Day Ceremonies in Cooma Monaro Shire and then a brief history of the Mosaic Time Walk. Katrin then introduced Jackie Graham, who with her late Husband Chris was in the forefront of this project.



Cooma Monaro Time Walk

The idea originated with Bill Joyce to display our regions rich history and after discussions with Chris Graham the then head of the Art Department at TAFE, Government grants were obtained and specialised glass tiles to complete the designs were imported from Italy.

The Historic Society decided on the theme for each panel, they were then sketched by the students at TAFE, enlarged to one square metre and painted onto a Masonite template. The glass tiles were then cut to match the picture and placed over the painted designs, covered in clear contact to hold them in place and keep dirt and grit out. They were then placed inside brass frames and pressed into a bed of cement and mounted on the walls where they are now displayed. The Time Walk was officially opened in August 1988. This was a great Community project with support from local businesses and service clubs. Without the skills and dedication of Chris Graham, and many students at our TAFE, including Katrin and Jackie, the Cooma
