## SUSAN GROENHOUT: The View Club



The guest speaker was Susan Groenhout, a National Councillor of VIEW.

Susan's area is bounded by Yass, Goulburn, Crookwell, Braidwood, ACT and down to Bombala, comprising 23 clubs and about 1200 members, there are 400 clubs with 23,000 members Australia wide, except in Tasmania & NT at this stage.

What is VIEW?

It is THE VOICE, INTERESTS AND

EDUCATION OF WOMEN, women supporting other women, children and families. It actively supports The Smith Family Program and has a commitment to provide education opportunities for Australian Children through the Learning for Life Program and a support network for women. The Smith Family founded VIEW in 1960 to ease the social isolation of women in society. Susan told us also of the foundation of The Smith Family, In the first 30 years of existence View donated \$8 Million to The Smith Family and their target is the PREVENTION OF FINANCIAL DISADVANTAGE rather than treating the symptoms. She also shared with us the AIMS of the LEARNING FOR LIFE program. At the present time 17,000 Australians are sponsoring 40 children, and since 1988, 40,000 children have benefitted from this program. A very interesting and informative address, which I am sure opened many eyes to what VIEW is and does. The second Guest Speaker was Dave Holgate's vote of thanks (a wonder the Sgt. didn't gong him for the length of his speech)
