is now 30 years old, but it is well maintained and serviced, and is in excellent condition. The chopper is called on up to five times a day and has been used 3,980 times in the last twelve years. At the present time there is no replacement required or planned. The operational area of the chopper is from the Victorian border west to Wagga and north to take in the ACT and Goulburn including the Snowy Mountains. Because of its night time search and rescue capability it is contracted for night services to Orange. The service is funded by several bodies, Costings are: Search and Rescue - Federal Government pay. ACT Primary - patient pays nothing, NSW Primary - billed by Ambulance Service NSW (not helicopter bill). Private health care covers cost, so if no private

health cover, patient pays. NSW Hospital to NSW Hospital - (e.g. Wagga Base to North Shore) hospitals split bill, patient pays nothing. NSW Hospital to Canberra Hospital - referring hospital picks up the bill, patient pays nothing. Canberra Hospital to Sydney Hospital; The Canberra Hospital billed but patient pays nothing. Well done Jenny, and we will see Jenny at our Changeover Dinner.
