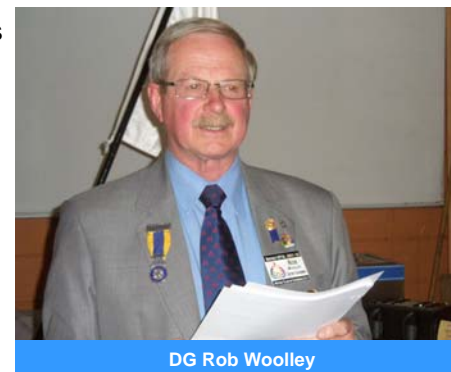

Guest speaker was the DG Rob Woolley who spoke on Rotary International President Kalyan's theme of "Reach within to Embrace Humanity", the Rotary International new Strategic Plan and the District Conference. President Kalyan has asked us to search first

When we understand, and truly feel that others' needs are the same as our own we begin to understand how important our work is. Kalyan said, in the year ahead, we will have three emphases in our Rotary service - family, continuity (finding things we do well and taking the next level) and change. There are three goals in the Strategic Plan - Support and Strengthen Clubs, Focus on and Increase Humanitarian Service and Enhance Public Image and Awareness. The theme, DG Woolley has chosen for the District Conference is "The World of Rotary Friendships and Fellowships". Rotary has over 50 Fellowships where friends get together to enjoy their hobbies, sport or special interest - fun, friendship and fulfillment. Dress for the Conference will be your hobby or sporting team, the only requirement is that it must comply with the Clubs dress code. The key-note speakers for the Conference include: Dr Alan Hawke AC - former Ambassador, Government Head and Chancellor of the Australia National University, who was awarded Australia's greatest civic hon-

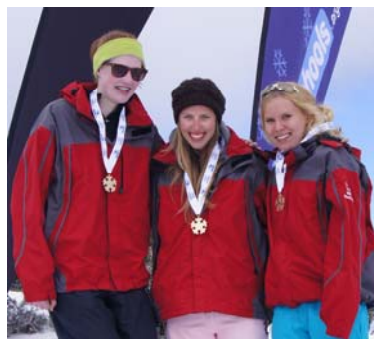
our in June 2010, being appointed a Companion of the Order of Australia. Andrew Lock OAM is the most accomplished high altitude mountaineer in Australian history. He is the only Australian, and the 18th man in the world, to climb all 14 of the world's 8,000m mountains. His achievements encompass 18 summits of those 8,000m peaks, including Mt Everest (twice); this places Andrew in a very select group of the world's best alpinists. David Copley is sponsored by Australia Rotary Health; David is the third Aboriginal person to become a nurse and the first to complete a Graduate Diploma in Mental Health Nursing. He is currently studying for a Masters of Nursing to improve Aboriginal Health standards. Suzi Duncan – founders of "Wheelie with Wings", creator of the "Vision air hand control" for pilots with lower limb disabilities. Suzi is a Commercial Pilot and Flight Instructor who herself has a disability. She is a pioneer in the world of disabled aviation and an inspiration to all. On the Saturday afternoon of the Conference there is an optional partners program which includes a one hour cruise, with commentary, on Lake Burley Griffin. The Conference is being held at the Hellenic Club in Canberra from the 21 to 23 October and we hope to see you all there.
