

ast weeks meeting was the Combined Services annual dinner, hosted by the View Club. Each club gave a report of their activities and a local singer sang

to entertain the diners. The guest speaker was Dr John Price who spoke on his time with the Royal Flying Doctor Service (RFDS). Dr Price gave us a short biography of John Flynn who received a letter from Lt. Clifford Peel, a medical student and aviator, who suggested the use of aircraft to bring medical services to outback people. Unfortunately Lt. Peel didn't live to see this happen, as he was shot down in France during WW1 at age 19. However, John Flynn campaigned to realise this idea. and with a beguest from HV McKay and Hudson Fysh, a founder of QANTAS, the aerial medical services began. Dr Price showed us a photo of the modern King Air plane used, single pilot flown, and highlighted the medical equipment stowed on board. Some of the clinics they visited including Wanaaring, Tibooburra, Ivanhoe, Wilcannia to name a few, they also visit-

ed remote outback stations. Dr Price also said that the National Health Advisory Committee of RFDS is engaged in recruitment and training of staff. He said at present Dr Carroll, from Cooma is presently working with the Royal Flying Doctor Service.
