In the toast to Rotary International, Past District Governor Michael Pedler gave an update on the Polio Eradication Project which started in 1985 when over 36500 sufferred with Polio. Since then, Rotary and the Bill Gates Foundation has spent over a billion dollars (US) in the persuit of Polio Eradication. In June 2011, only 650 cases were reported world wide and in June 2012 – only 78 cases. There were no cases in India in the last 12 months.

One of Katrin's last duties was to induct new member Mark John Nateley into the Club. Mark's family were present including his fellow Rotarian father from Leongatha, David John.

Katrin thanked all members and especially the board for their support and assistance over the last 12 months. Katrin also handed out several Appriciation Certificates to other members.
