
Guest Speaker: Jarrod Sopniewski — RYPEN

We were given a special treat this week, the meeting was opened with some entertainment provided by Tamar John-Natley on violin.

Our guest speaker this week was Jarrod Sopniewski a year 9 student from Snowy Mountains Christian School, who was our RYPEN representative at Moggo in May. Jarred is very active in sport, including Rugby, basketball and athletics. He also plays trombone in the school and town band and a band in Canberra.

In speaking about his RYPEN experience he said that he caught a bus from Canberra with 8 other students. On arrival at Moggo he discovered that there were 51 other representatives. His group made a total of 60 people, there were 30 girls and 30 boys. On arrival they were split into 8 groups and were accommodated 8 to a unit. On the first day they had an ice-breaker to get to know each other. During the camp they were addressed by several speakers on leadership matters, alcohol and drug problems and on life skills. There was also a variety of other activities for them to participate in including aerobics and a bush dance night, this event helped all students to associate with each other. The meals were excellent! And they liked you to come back for seconds or even thirds, one person came back for sevenths (talk about good food).
