Tamara opened her speech with her Italian introduction to her host Rotary Club. Then she explained why she wanted to be an exchange student. She said she was always fascinated by different cultures and travelling. She heard about the exchange program when she was in Year 8 when Clare Learoyd was becoming an exchange student. Tamara decided to look into it and expressed interest to her family. She went to RYPEN for the first time where her interest, positivity and perseverance to be an exchange student was enhanced. The following year she returned to RYPEN as a mentor, had filled her application filled in for exchange and became even more sure of being an exchange student. She brought Akram (the 2013 Young Australian of the Year) to Cooma and was encouraged by him to follow her passion and not give up on becoming an exchange student

She was accepted following the interview process and is going to Sarzana a town in the North West of Italy. It has a population of 21,978. The temperature in Summer averages 28 with a recorded high of 40, in Winter the average is 3.4 with a recorded low of -5. Her first host family are Giovanni, Maria, Illara (20) & Guglielmo (18) Hinrichsens and she will be going to school at T.Parentuccelli.

Some of the things she is looking forward to learning about, seeing and doing are the 2 castles, the history of Pope Nicholas V who was Pope in 1397. The military importance of the town since it has changed hands a number of times due to its position; belonging first to Pisa, then to Florence, then to the Banco di S. Giorgio of Genoa and from 1572 to part of the principality of Genoa. She is also excited about the world renowned annual guitar festival, the food, shopping, skiing in the Alps, having a different cultural experience, making new friends and learning a beautiful language, gaining new strengths and independence and having an amazing time. She closed by thanking Cooma Rotary Club for helping to make this trip possible.

At the end of the evening President Hass presented Tamara with her official green Rotary travel blazer.










