

Prior to the meeting, the club members visited the control room at Snowy Hydro, the visit organised by Elaine Mooney. KIERAN CUSACK, MANAGER GENERATION OPERATIONS, spoke to us there, and then after dinner. Snowy Hydro has 7 hydro power stations plus two mini stations and three gas turbine stations. The company now has 5,500 megawatts capacity and 670 megawatts pumping capacity. There are dams, viaducts and tunnels and all are operated from the control room that the club members viewed before dinner.

Snowy Hydro owns Red Energy that recently acquired Lumo Power with four diesel powered power stations. The stations are scattered over South Australia, Victoria and New South Wales. Red Energy now supplies power to 1,000,000 consumers. The company, more interested in rural customers than those in the city, started in Victoria and is now targeting customers in New South Wales. There are also industrial and commercial customers. Red Energy has a 'Pay on time' discount on the entire bill and the price is fixed until June 2015.

Because the bulk of the power is from hydro, the scheme is able to come online within five minutes – other generated power is unable to move as quickly.

Snowy Hydro is owned by different states, New South Wales having the majority. CEO is Paul Broad and Ken Lister is Chief Operating Officer.
