#### **BACK TO COOMA WEEKEND**

People who have volunteered to help with crowd control during the procession of floats are to attend a meeting at the Alpine Hotel at 6pm on Tuesday.

The club will be catering for the rodeo on the Saturday, 3 to 4 members needed. The new Rotaractors will be asked to help.

There will be a 50s/60s dance at the Ex-Services Club on the Saturday night. Elaine S will be grateful for help with decorating the room and tables on the Saturday morning and help on the door on the night.

GUEST SPEAKER – Chris Kimball, CEO Snowy Hydro SouthCare Helicopter

An inspiring speaker, Chris spoke about the service, established in the late 90s, that has made over 6000 flights. The service area extends north to Orange, west to Hay, south to the Victorian border, and up the east coast from Eden to Ulladulla.

He told his personal story of being diagnosed with non-Hodgkin's lymphoma when his children were just 6 and 2, the difficulty of not

being able to touch them when he was undergoing chemotherapy, and the knowledge that he was given just a 50-50 chance of surviving.

He is proud of the helicopter service, giving examples of rescued patients who have gone from strength to strength, especially a boy whose leg had to be amputated below the knee after being involved in a farm accident. That boy will be competing in the 100 metres run at the coming Paralympics.







The fine session and raffle raised \$250 that was donated to the Colinton Fire Brigade, represented by Tony Robinson. Members of the Fire Brigade and its supporters provided a delicious meal at the meeting.
