District Assembly: Mark C, Danielle and Mark JN attended. A change has been made to some Rotary rules: meetings will not have to be weekly (minimum of 2 meetings a month); there is no requirement for attendance to be recorded, but the number of service hours must be submitted so that they can be considered when there are government grants being handed out; a person can be a member of only one service organisation (except for Rotaract and Rotary). Other clubs have already been having fortnightly meetings and on the off week they have been having more informal gettogethers.

Dugald - A motion was put to the meeting: That 25% of the fees collected from stallholders at the markets should be deposited in the General Account and 25% into the Market Promotion Account (50% to Project Account). Motion carried.

Darrell moved that hire fees of \$200 for the feed van and \$100 for the coffeee van should be paid to the General Account whenever they are used to raise funds for the project account, the charges to be retrospective to the beginning of the 2015-16 year. Motion to be discussed by the board.
