THREE MINUTER: Jeannette

Jeannette spoke about her great-uncle, William, whose name is on the WWI honour roll at the War Memorial. He enlisted in 1915 and fought on the Western Front. Jeannette has transcribed his diary and the letters he wrote to his family, a difficult task because of brittle paper, her uncle's writing style, his use of abbreviations and the inroads made by silverfish. His letters expressed concern for his family at home and his orchard, never about the difficulties he himself was having. He was wounded badly by shrapnel, spent five months in England and then returned to the war zone as a company clerk. He was killed in April 1917. His family received a 'dead man's penny' after his death.
