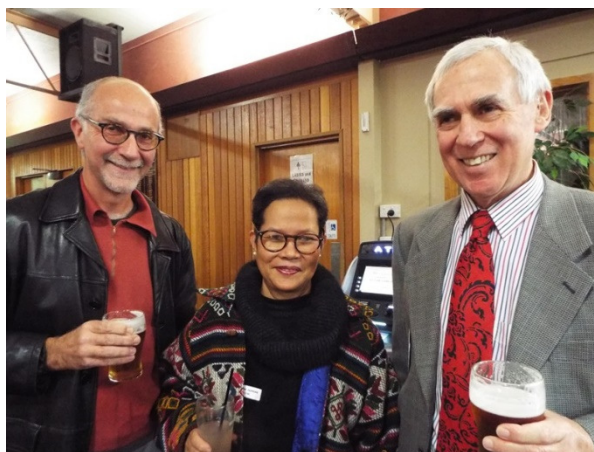

He spoke about Rotary Foundation and the great work it has done in helping to reduce the incidence of polio from over 300,000 cases per year in the 80s to the present when it has been 99.99% eradicated. There are only two countries, Afghanistan and Pakistan, that are still reporting cases and this year to date the number is 15. Michael commended the club on its progress and its contributions to the local community and globally.
