### **THREE MINUTER - Richard Brown**

The son of a soldier settler, Richard was able to tell us of the success, through hard work, of their block at Bobundara. In 1948, a group of soldier settlers came to the Monaro to take up parts of the land that had been resumed by the government from the Australia and New Zealand Land Company. Bobundara, 16,000 acres and a sister property to Dromore, was divided up and only the home block had any buildings, so the new settlers had to build their properties from scratch with the help of low interest loans.

Katrin and Hass attended the District Changeover and the new District Governor, Steve Hill, was inducted. There were many familiar faces there including Noel Trevaskis who is an International Director. It is hoped that more Cooma members will attend this function in the future.
