David H told us that Charlotte Wood, daughter of the late John and Felicia Wood, has won the Prime Minister's Award for Fiction.










EARLY WARNING: The District Conference will be held in Cooma in October 2018. There will be many jobs to do and many people will be called on to help.



### **GUEST SPEAKER - Dr Robert Wiles**



Rob spoke about the brain as the most complex entity in the universe, with 100 billion neurons that each have 1000 connections which in turn have 150 neurotransmitters. He likened the brain to a computer so that the hardware, the material, is the physical brain and the mind, the non-material, is the software.

There has been much discussion among philosophers, psychologists, neurologists, neuroscientists on the mind-brain connection, including Rene Descartes and Marvin Minsky. No scientist has been able to explain awareness or consciousness in scientific terms, although it is recognised that consciousness is like the operating system in our brain. In humans, consciousness leads to self-awareness.

# Consciousness (awareness



- Consciousness is not understood in scientific terms
- · Can be imaged on an EEG wave patterns
- · Consciousness is like the operating system
- Insects are hard-wired instead; lack versatility (zombies)
- On dying, our stream of consciousness is lost from our bodies but the physical cells remain.
- · Cell death result from physical damage to cells
- Brain death results from the loss of something nonphysical as the physical body remains unchanged.
- · No 'consciousness centre' everywhere but nowhere
